WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW About Monkeypox

Currently there is an outbreak of monkeypox in Massachusetts. Monkeypox is a rare viral infection that anyone can get and spread to others once symptoms start. There is a vaccine for monkeypox and infection is preventable.

HOW IT SPREADS

Intimate skin-to-skin or skin-to-mouth contact with a monkeypox rash, sores, or scabs

Prolonged contact with clothing, bedding, or surfaces used by someone with monkeypox



Sexual contact



Hugging, massaging, or kissing

People with monkeypox are contagious from the beginning of symptoms until the rash and sores have healed and disappeared.
